You can fly with SAS from Stockholm Arlanda airport. Flight time from Stockholm is 50 min.

Flight arrivals 18th of April - to Sundsvall 13.05, 16.00, 18.40

Flight departures 19th of April - from Sundsvall 16.25, 18.55, 20.45

There will be a bus transfer available for NSPA Forum participants connected to the arriving flights at 13.05 and at 16.00 on the 18th April to take participants to the study visits and to the hotel. There will also be a bus transfer available from the hotel to Midlanda airport in connection to the flight at 16.25 on the 19th April.
