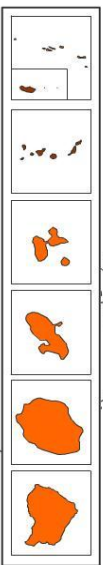
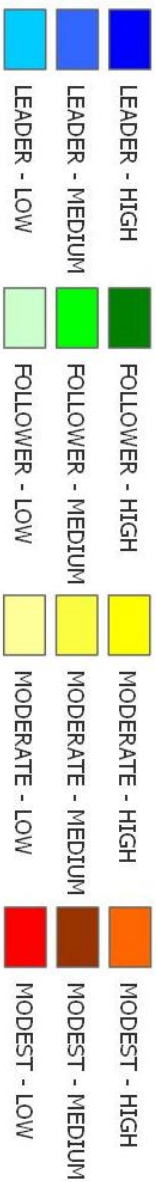

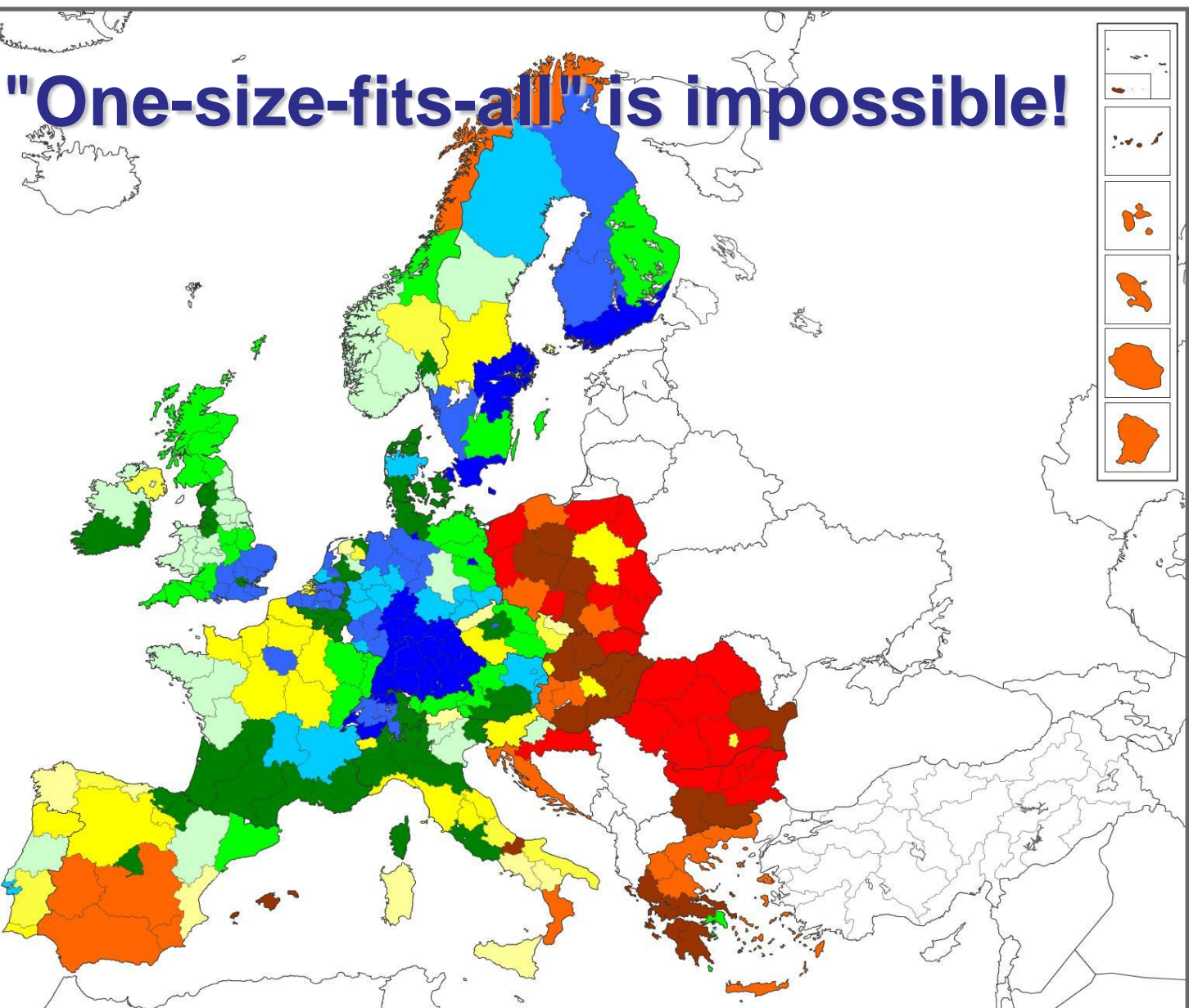


Regional Innovation Scoreboard 2012

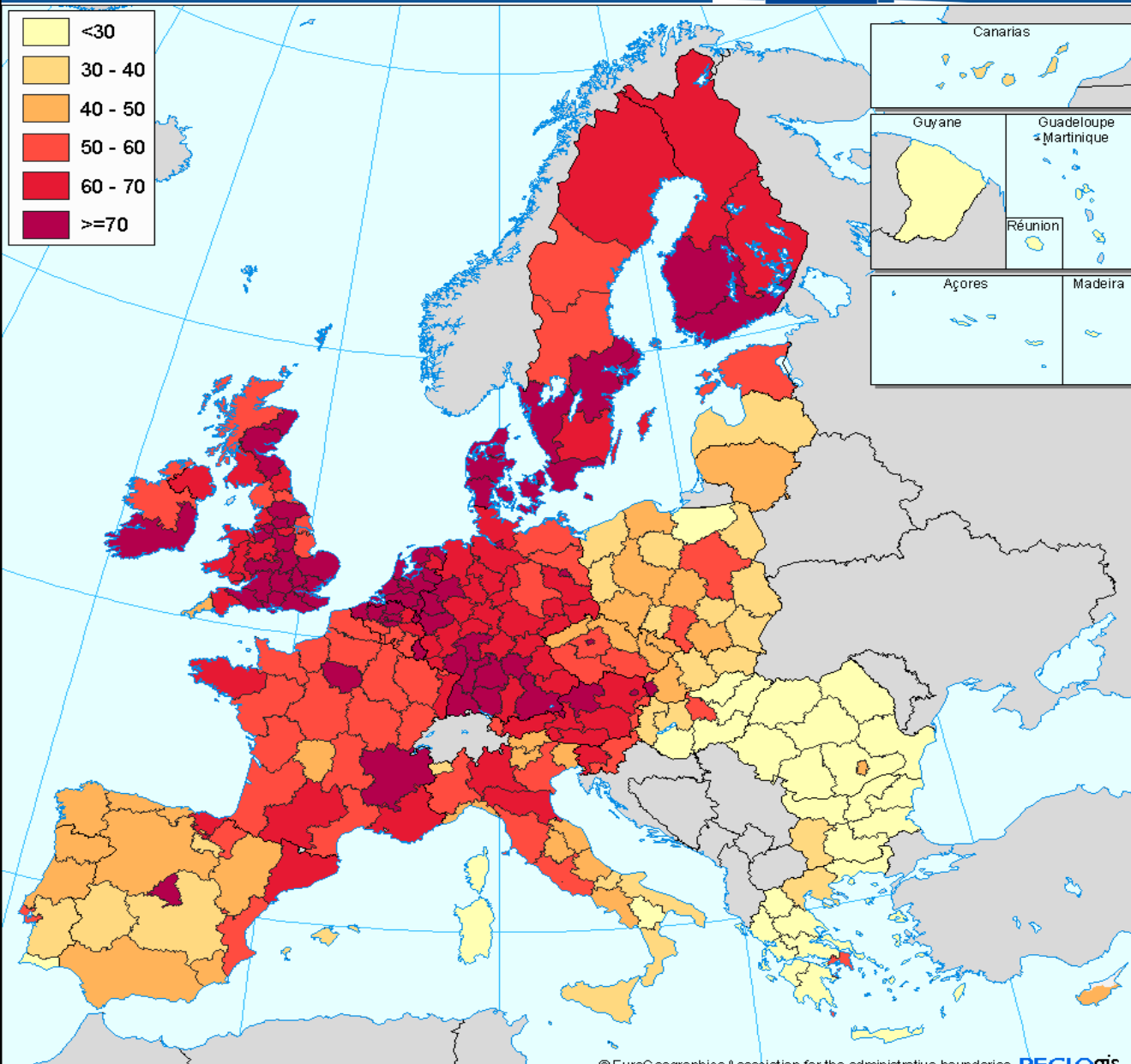


"One-size-fits-all" is impossible!

What is Smart Specialisation ?

= innovation as driver for **structural change**

= **fact-based**: all assets

= no top-down but **process + shared vision among innovation stakeholders, in particular business**

= **All forms of innovation** – not only technology and research driven

= **eco-systems**: creating environments for change

= Mobilisation of investments and synergies **across different departments and governance levels** (EU-national-regional)

= **source-in** knowledge, & technologies

= **Be different!**

= **competitive advantages**, potential for excellence, opportunities

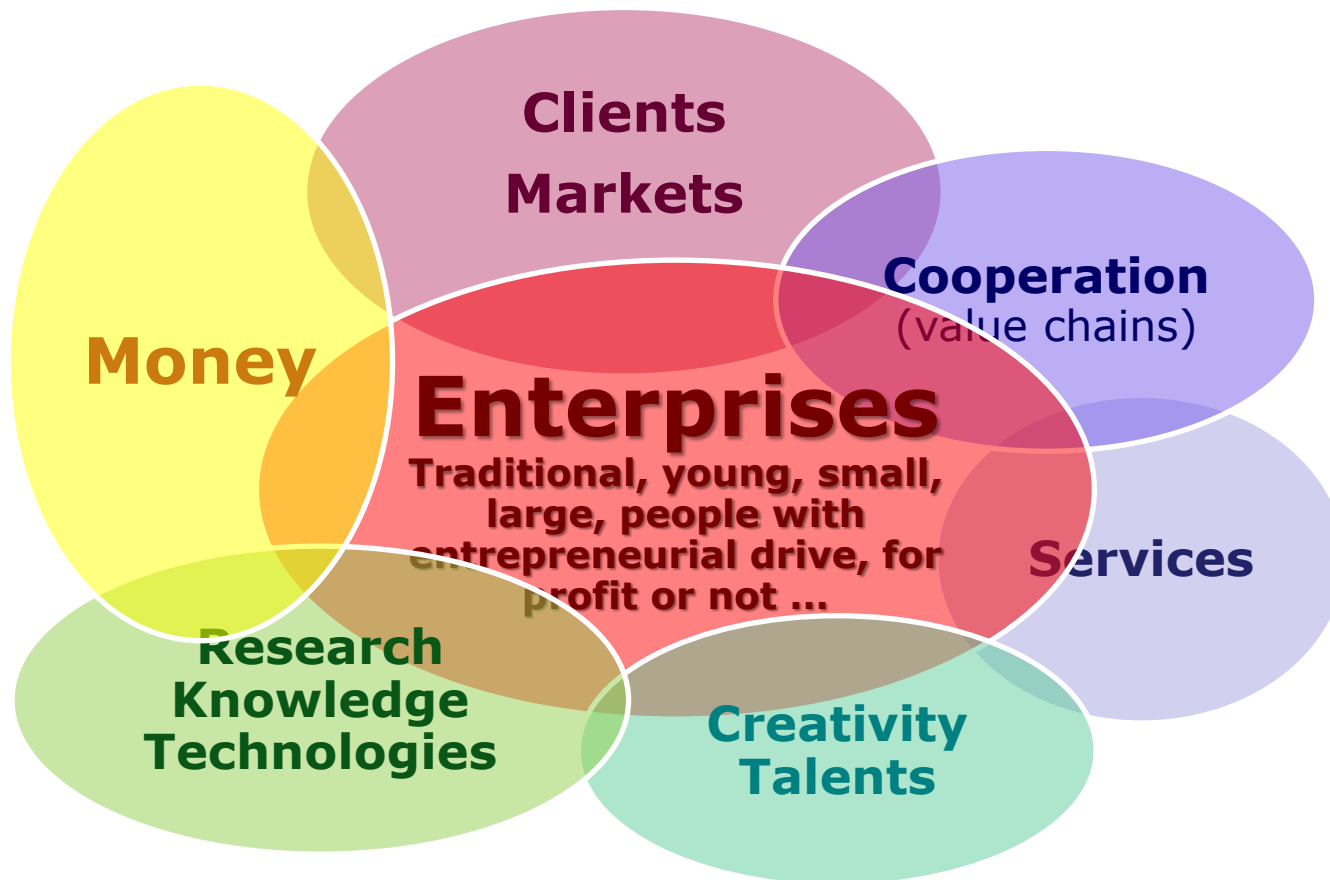
= **global perspective** on potential competitive advantage + potential for cooperation, global value chains

= **Concentration** of resources on priorities, problems and core needs

= accumulation of **critical mass**

= not necessarily focus on a single sector, but **cross-fertilisations**, rejuvenating traditional sectors through higher value-added activities

RIS3 is a process ... of «entrepreneurial discovery»

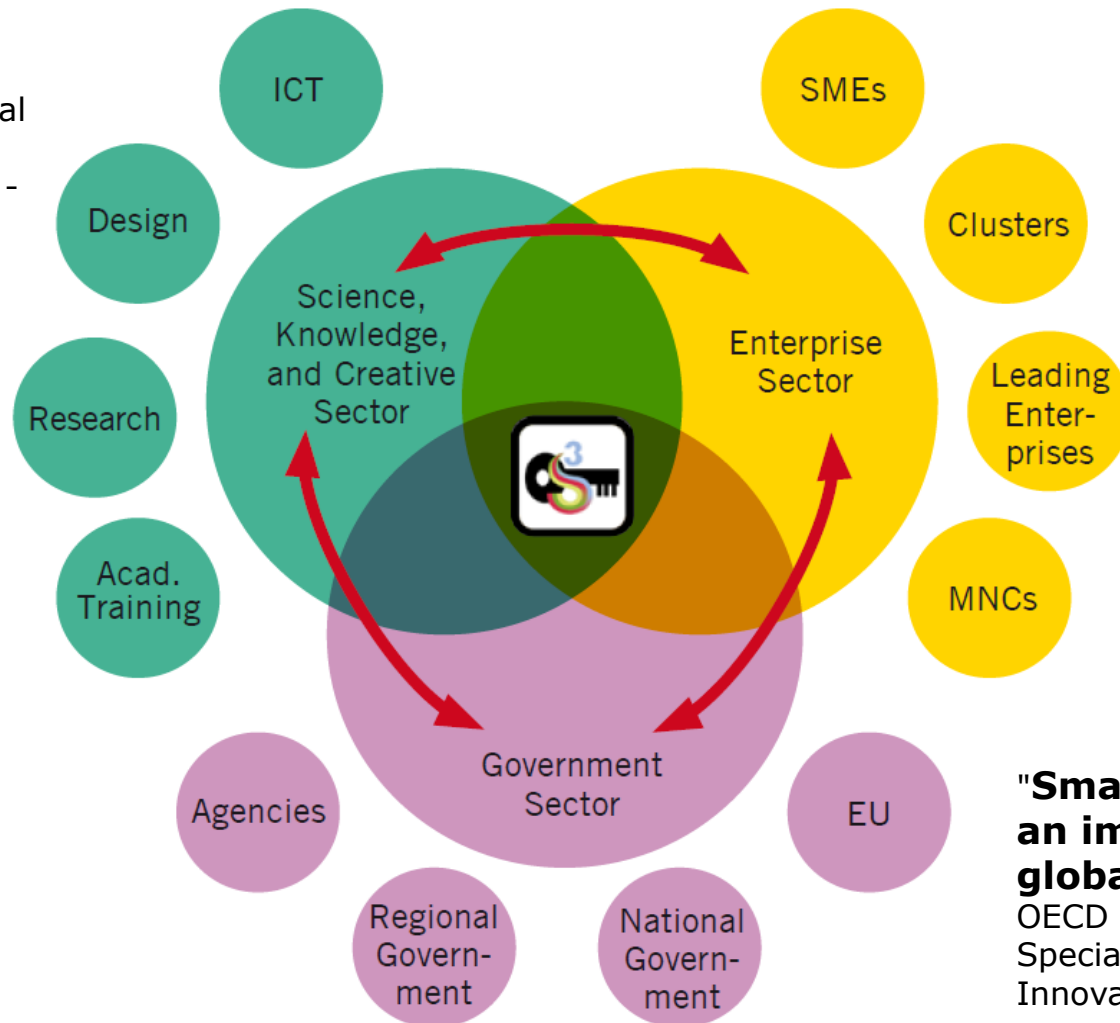

Great theory, but in my region there are no universities nor research institutes nor any creative sector nor large anchor firms nor clusters of industries with critical mass and only very few people ...

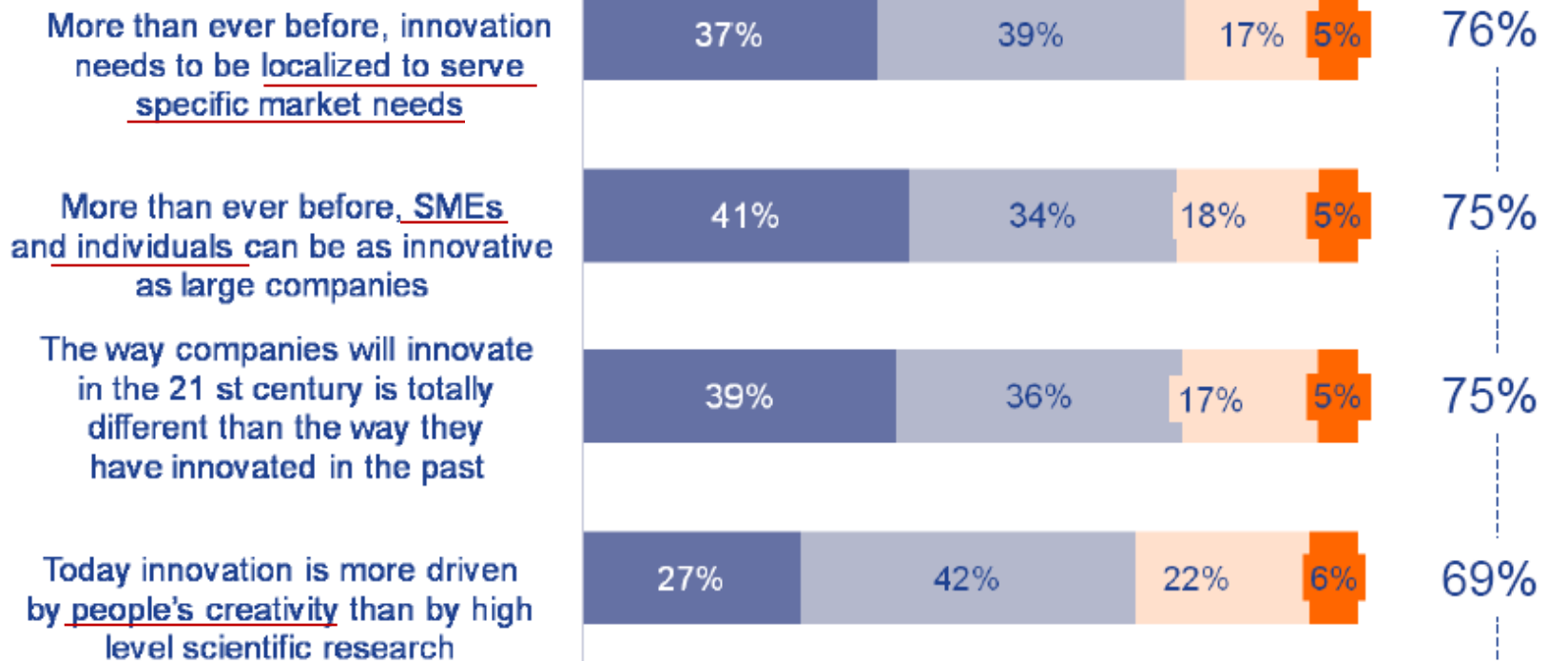

Examples

- Assets:**
- Permanently cold weather
 - No neighbours who would mind noise
 - Close-knit community where strangers/spies are immediately spotted

Northern Sweden:

winter car testing facilities in Arjeplog (60 kilometers south of the Arctic Circle) attracted Daimler, Volkswagen, Toyota, General Motors, Ford, Fiat, Peugeot, Saab, and Hyundai

- Rather cold weather
 - Nothing around but trees
 - Labour forces' main competence: handling forest machinery

North Karelia (Finland):

Forest cluster brought structural change from wood production to forest machinery, chemicals, packaging, logistics

East Wales:

OpTIC Technium (a RegioStars winner) is a technology and incubation centre in St Asaph that was set up under the initiative of the enterprises and universities in the opto-electronics cluster organisation in North Wales to provide support, knowledge and facilities for emerging technology businesses

Examples

Navarra (Spain):

Wind energy has generated an active industrial and productive sector in the region: turbine assembly, manufacture of blades, turbines, towers and control equipment, and other wind turbine components ...

Assets:

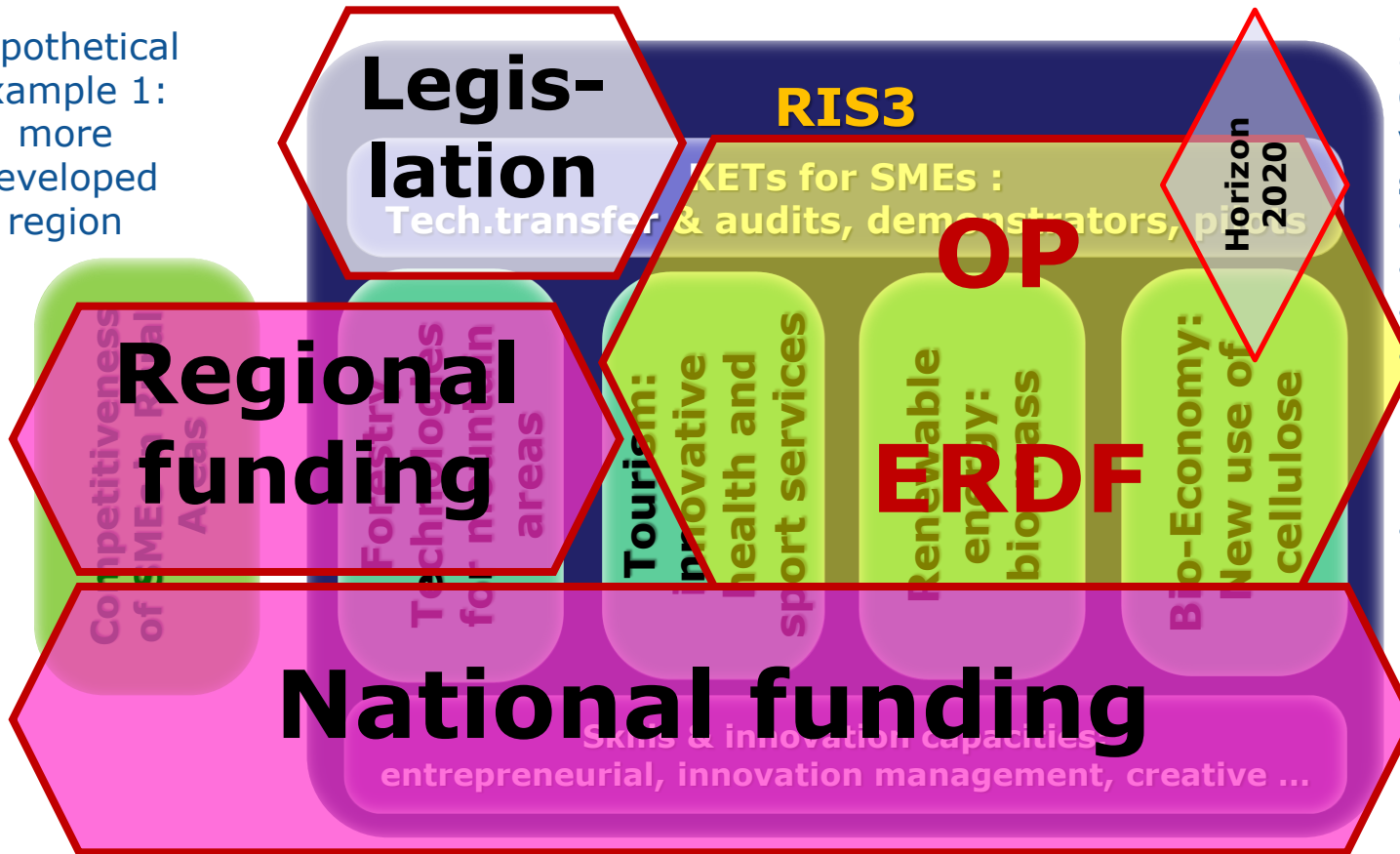
- **Lots of wind ...**

- *"Proximity matters", but so does creativity, community-based initiatives, virtual networks ...*
- *Be different: the mix makes it - both inside your region and by seeking cooperation with other regions ...*
- *Building on ALL types of assets in a region ...even those that look like a disadvantage*

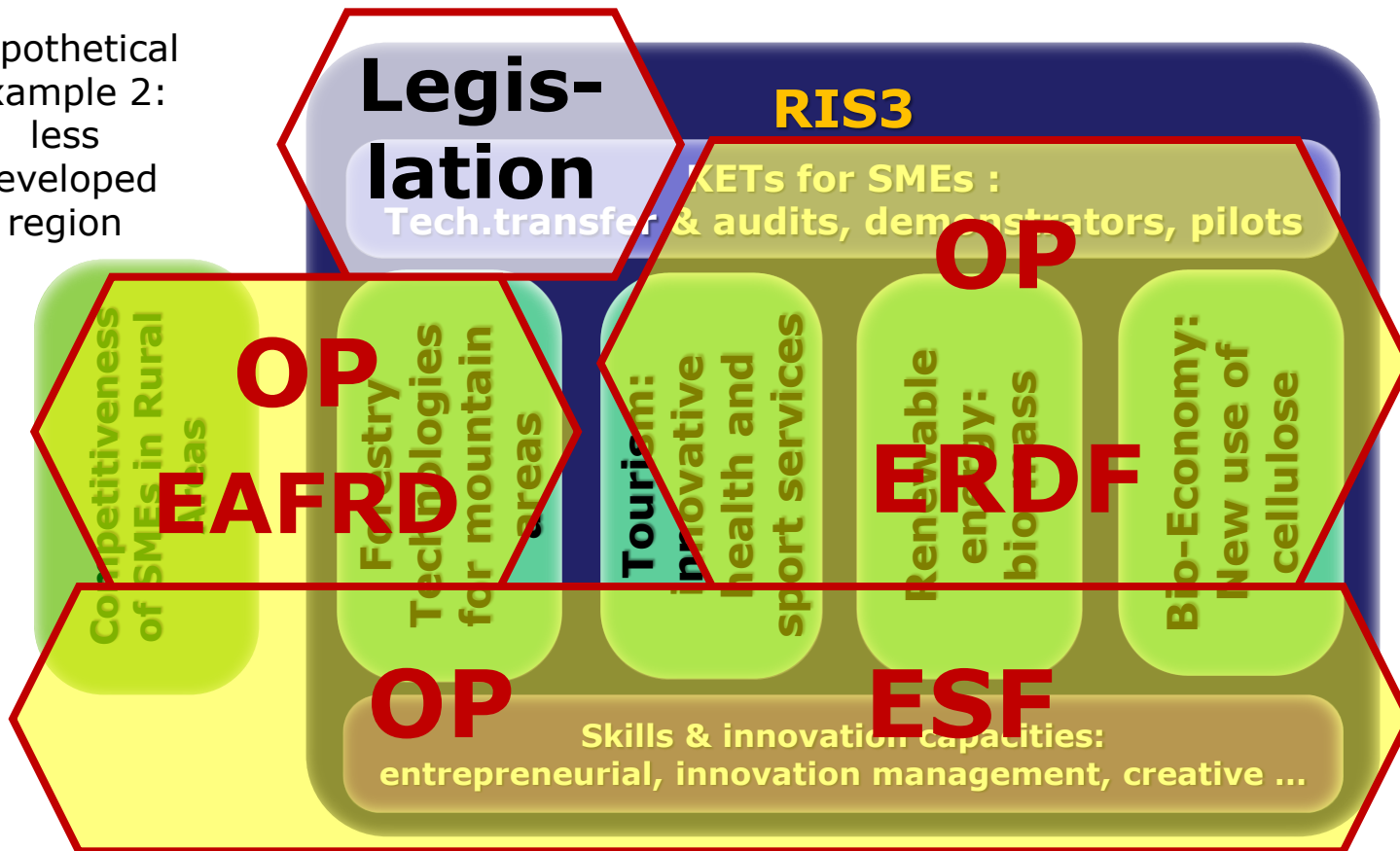

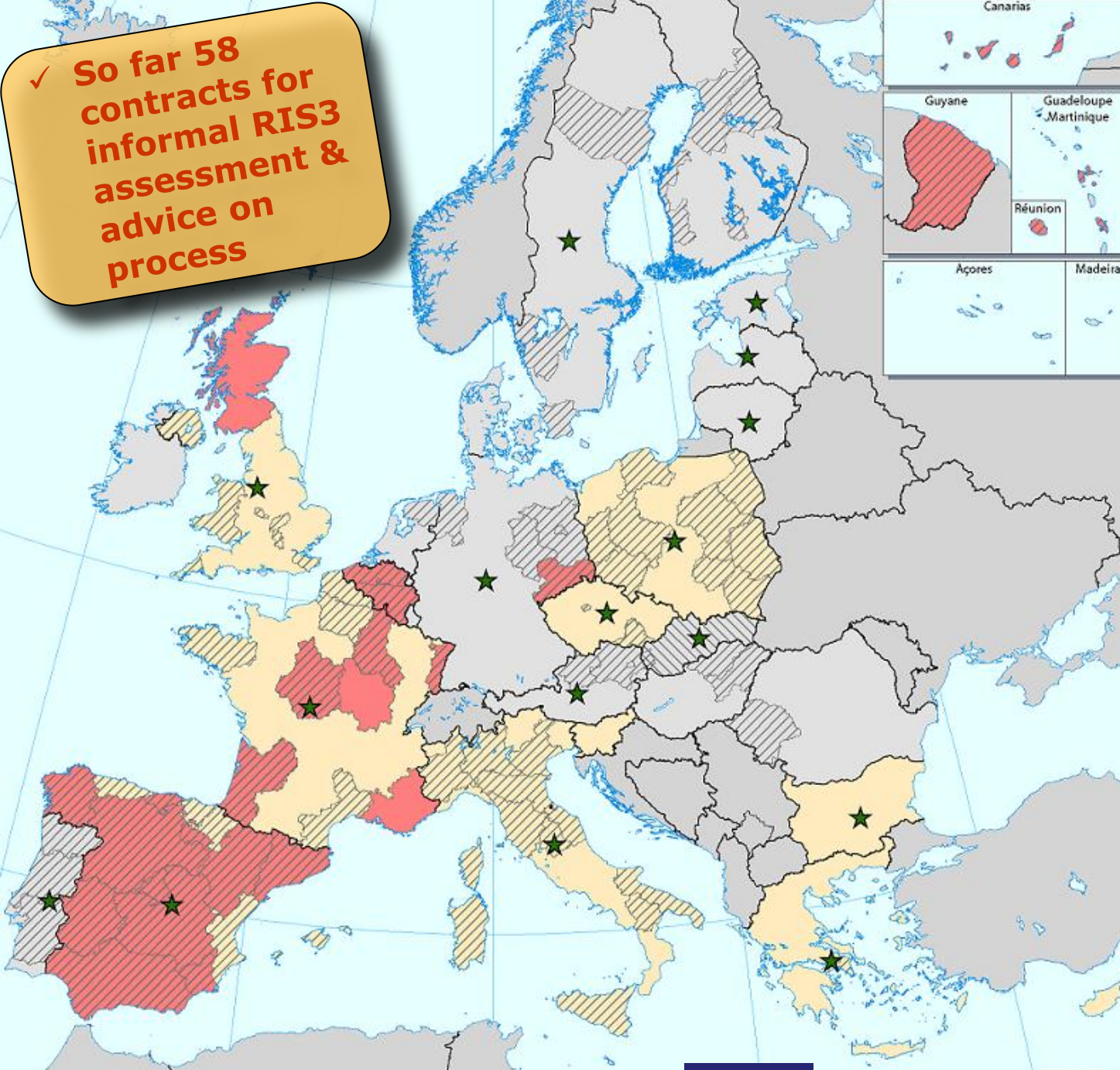

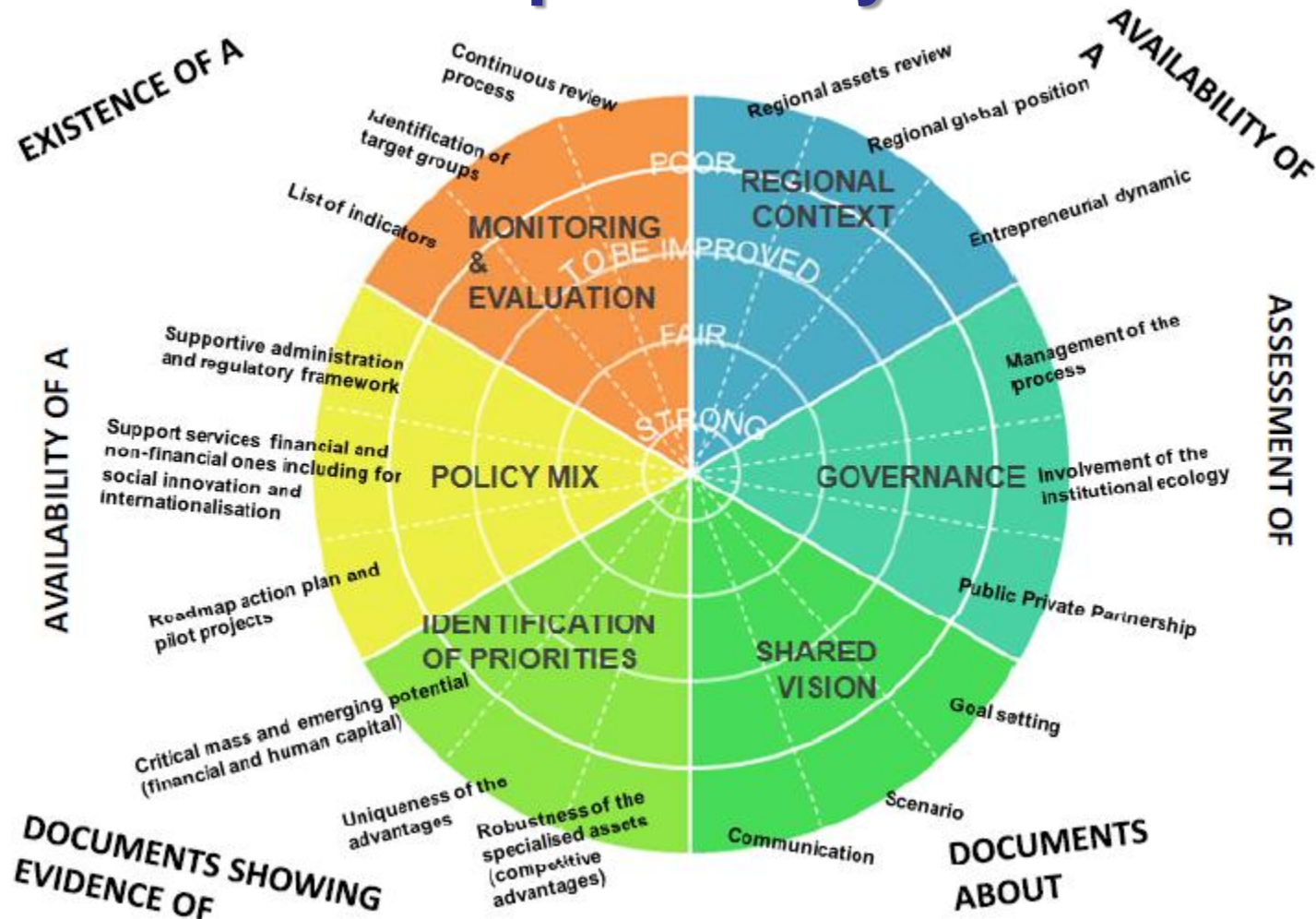
